The young artist's wall-mounted dioramas of unprepossessing sites in New York, lovingly fashioned from hand-painted foam core, are elegies to a vanishing downtown. The dive bar Sophie's appears at the foot of a tenement, its neon beer logos transformed into gravestones for the East Village, before gentrification. The artist repainted a mural that is painted on the façade of a Rite Aid—a lo-fi *mise en abyme*. The show includes some abstractions on paper, which, although competent, confirm that Buffon is at his best in three dimensions.
